

## SOME MARINE AND OTHER SERVICES AND SUPPLIERS IN LABUAN

This directory has been compiled by Sue & John Woods on MV Solita, with help from Alistair Muir on SV C'est la Vie and other yachtees who visited the Labuan Marina between October 2014 and March 2015. All details were correct at that time, but bear in mind business details often change frequently here. This list does not include all goods suppliers and services in Labuan but is a list of businesses used by yachtees and deemed worthy of recommendation to others. The map references on the far right relate to the tourist map of Labuan Town given out by the local Tourist Information Office, next to the Poslaju office & Museum.

## PLACES TO VISIT IN LABUAN

The Tourism Office, situated between Labuan Walk and Jalan Merdeka, and next to main museum, offers free maps of the island, with the town map on the reverse side is used in the above guide as reference points for the locations of some of the services listed. The Tourist Office also has some brochures about places to visit in Labuan. They have a website ([www.labuantourism.my](http://www.labuantourism.my)) which lists coming events but this is written in Malay. There is an active community facebook site (“I love Labuan”) which posts many local events and places to visit, as well as community announcements. Places that we enjoyed here in Labuan were:

PLACE	ADDRESS/HOW TO GET THERE	INFORMATION
Papan Island	This is the small green island at the entrance to Labuan, or Victoria, Harbour. Only access is via your own dinghy or by water taxi (which will charge you a lot – possibly 150RM for drop-off and pick-up).	There is a small but very tidy resort on the western side, with a long jetty. There seems to be no admittance charge or landing fee. The resort is closed on Sunday, so no employees present. On the eastern side there is a lovely bay with sandy beaches, shady grassed areas for picnics – this side is frequented by locals who were very friendly to us. Water is clean, great for swimming. Just beware the many small submerged rocks and reef that surround the island.
Papayas Beach Lodge	On NE coast of Labuan. Check their website or “I love Labuan” facebook posting for directions via Google map.	Small local resort and bar/restaurant on the beach, famous for their hamburgers. Mainly used by locals, it has a laid/back relaxed atmosphere. They often hold events, eg Full-Moon parties.
WW2 Memorial/Cemetery	On east coast of island – follow Jalan Tanjung Purun (road along the north side of Financial Park) for approx. 5kms.	Large memorial park with grave markers dating to WW2 set in beautiful gardens. There is a moving service held here every Nov.
